



2011 - 2012 Senior Scholarship Process Information and Instructions

The Allen Orchestra Booster Club invites all Senior Orchestra Students who are college bound to apply for a Scholarship from the Allen Orchestra Booster Club.

Number and Value of Scholarships

2 scholarships of \$1000 will be awarded.

Judging

All scholarships will be judged blind with the candidates name removed and a candidate number assigned. We have enlisted three Judges from the state of Texas that have diverse backgrounds who will judge independently of one another.

The judges will be given explicit instructions for ranking the candidates in order, following the review of the student's application and essay, from first to last, corresponding with the total number of applications/essays submitted.

The results of the judge's rankings will be tabulated by a non-senior parent and presented to the orchestra directors.

Following the determination of the number of scholarships, the scholarships will be awarded as judged.

Announcement of Scholarship Recipients

Scholarship recipients will be announced at the 2012 Orchestra Banquet Ceremony. Awards will be distributed to the student and made out to the university listed on the application. Actual awards are made in June (or before). The check will be sent to the home address listed on the application.

- Winners will be announced at the 2012 Orchestra Banquet
- Awards will be distributed directly to the student AND will be made out to their chosen university/college for use towards their college endeavors

Instructions to Scholarship Candidates

Please answer all application questions, complete the essay, sign the certification, and then return the materials in a sealed envelope to the Orchestra Office by the end of school on Wednesday, April 4th. Applications received after this time, will not be considered.

Detailed Student Candidates Instructions

- Requirements: The scholarship process includes the following three (3) requirements. ALL requirements must be met to be considered. Failure to submit ALL the requirements will disqualify the student from consideration.
 1. Completed Scholarship Application
 2. Written Essay (typed on separate paper, double-spaced, 650 words or less.)
 3. Certification of Application (signature on first page of application)

Essay Topic My music education and Orchestra experience at Allen High

Delivery: The application, the essay and the certification must be submitted in a sealed envelope. Failure to submit the requirements in this manner will disqualify the student from consideration. On the front of the envelope write: "Scholarship Applicant". DO NOT write your name on the outside of the envelope.

2011 - 2012 Scholarship Judging Guidelines

Objective: To recognize, honor and financially award outstanding Senior Orchestra students who are college bound and who have been impacted by their orchestra experience in the Allen ISD.

1. Application Process

- Judges will not see the personal information (name, etc.) regarding the applicant
- Judges should make their decisions and submit their results by or before the date of **Monday, April 30, 2012** using the guidelines below. The applications, individual score sheets and summary score sheet should be returned to Booster Club President, Mary Gaudio by this date.

2. Selection Committee/Judges

- Judges should have diverse backgrounds from the arts to business, and will be selected based on availability. Judges will reside in the state of Texas and will not be directly associated with Allen High School Orchestra.

3. Selection Guidelines

- At least a 2.80 GPA to be considered by award
- Judges should rank the applications in order to be awarded based on the total number of applicants. For instance, if they receive 10 applicants they would rank the entire group 1st place through 10th place.
- Each application section should be weighted as follows:

Academic Information	10%
Orchestra/Music Information	30%
Community Service	10%
Essay	50%

Essay should reflect upon the topic:
